Palladiano Durello Brut (Italy) (v+) Apples, pear and youthful bubbles. 35

Cava Mas Macià Brut NV (Spain) White fruit and citrus aromas lead onto a complex palate with green apple, stone fruit and a touch of white spice. 42

Domaine Bellevue Cremant de Loire NV (France) Deep burnished gold colour, dry and rich with a long and satisfying finish. Clean red apple flavour with a hint of savoury pastry.

REFRESHING, CITRUS, LIGHT

Maison De Vigneron Sec, Côtes de Gascogne (France, 19) (v+) Plenty of ripe, green fruit aromas and flavours such as lime and crisp apples, with a zingy mouthfeel and a clean finish. 27

Antonio Borga Pinot Grigio (Italy, 20) (v+) An deliciously juicy Pinot Grigio from the Veneto region. Delightfully refreshing, with pear and lemon flavours that demand 'one more sip'. 30

Picpoul de Pinet, Duc de Morny (France, 20) (v) Floral and enticing on the nose, exuberantly fresh on the palate with pear drop fruit, a slightly salty edge and underlying minerality. 26

Albariño, Calazul (Spain, 19) A nose dominated by fresh citrus belies an indulgent, creamy palate and a long, zesty finish. As perfect a crisp white wine as you could hope to find.

Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, Cloud Factory (New Zealand, 21) Perfumed with nettle and ripe tropical fruits. These flavours are evident on the palate too along with limey flavours and a rich minerality - a truly classic Marlborough Sauvignon.

Grüner Veltliner, Franz & Friends (Austria, 19) Aromatic nose with notes of white spice. Stone fruit, green apple and lightly exotic characters. 40

Henners Native Grace Barrel Fermented Chardonnay (East Sussex, 18) (v) Apple, lemon and stone fruit aromas with some toasty and buttery notes and a citrus streak. Delicate spice and creamy, textural richness from time spent in barrel.

ROSE

Serenissima Pinot Grigio Blush (Italy, 21) Pale and delicate, with soft cherry flavour. Elegant and easy to love. 30

Guillame Aurele Rosé (France, 21)

Round and easy drinking rosé from a hidden corner of Southern France. Soft berry fruits fill the mouth and treat the palate. 33

Côtes de Thau Rosé, Maison Boutinot (France, 20) (v) Rich currant flavours provided by Grenache and tangy raspberry from Cinsault before a dry and fresh finish

Silver Myn, Argentum, Zorgvliet (South Africa, 21) (v) Black cherry and mulberry fruit show through on the palate along with spice, all leading to a well-integrated, elegant tannin structure 30

Chateau La Garenne, Bordeaux Rouge (France, 19) Dark berry, earthy, subtle mint tones 36

Chianti Reserva, Uggiano `La Scoperta` (Italy, 19) (v+) Plum, blackcurrant and black cherry fruits with a hint of spice 36

Chateau Batailley Grand Cru Classé, Pauillac 2007 Serious claret from the most ageworthy village in Bordeaux, Batailley is famous for its taut blackcurrant heart with graphite and earth backbone. Now 15 years old, it's entering its peak drinking window.

Chateau Kirwan Grand Cru Classé, Margaux 2004 Founded in 1760 in the elegant village of Margaux, Chateau Kirwan has a reputation for full-flavoured wines that maintain a perfect balance as they age, and this is warming, earthy and lovely.

Grand Cru St Emilion, Clos de la Cure (France, 19) (v+) An incredibly powerful, rich nose of ripe blackcurrants and chocolate and a full ripe lingering flavour 84 (Magnum available)

FRUITY, MEDIUM-BODIED

Merlot Mourvédre, Les Oliviers, Pays d'Oc (France, 21) (Organic) Supple and lithe, the deep smooth tannins wholly integrated to form a rich satisfying finish 28

Zensa Primitivo, (Italy, 20) (Organic) Ripe red fruit bursts from this exuberant Southern Italian treat. Full of flavour, with a silky texture, it's a delicious expression of Primitivo 34

Cairanne, Côtes du Rhone, La Côte Sauvage, Boutinot (France, 19) (v+) Cherry and a touch of sweet spice, ripe berry, liquorice, chocolate, summer pudding, a hint of cinnamon spice 52

Pinot Noir de Bourgogne, Pierre Bourée (France, 21) (v+) Garnet and light in colour, lots of strawberries and earthy notes like any great Burgundian Pinot Noir 66
